Dear Church Family and Friends,

Today, I have a story to share with you about a man that had a drastically changed life as a result of God's Word.

This man grew up in a town that was full of wickedness. His family did not worship the one, true God. Many generations ago, there were some men in his family tree that walked closely with God, but other than that he grew up in a community that was much more prone to worship idols than the living God.

One day, God told this man to leave everything behind and head west. He wasn't able to take much of his stuff or family. He left town with his wife, nephew, and his father. After going about halfway, they stopped at a place and began to settle there. While they were in this town, the man's father died.

God once again spoke to the man and told him that he wasn't yet in the place that he was supposed to be. In fact, God told him that he was going to be a great man in a great land. So, he, his wife, and his nephew kept moving.

Finally, they arrived at the place to which God had told him to go. Somewhere along the line, the man had learned that the living God was the real God while all those idols that he had left behind were powerless. Therefore, one of the first things that the man did was make a place where he could worship the one, true, living God.

If you haven't guessed, the man that I have been talking about is Abraham. God made some incredible promises to Abraham and Abraham trusted and obeyed God to such an extent that he has the largest "display" in the Faith Hall of Fame found in Hebrews 11.

Do you know how this man connects with your life? The Bible tells us: **"Abraham believed God, and it was reckoned to him as righteousness. Therefore, be sure that it is those who are of faith who are sons of Abraham. The Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, 'All the nations will be blessed in you.' So then those who are of faith are blessed with Abraham, the believer."** (Galatians 3:6-9)

I hope that you and I have faith that is worth writing about – like the faith of Abraham. May God bless you as you put your complete faith in Him.
